**5. Introduction to Robotics (Grades 3-5)**

This class is designed by Carnegie Mellon University's National Robotics Engineering Consortium and uses the motivational advantages of robotics to teach math, science, and technology concepts. The class is aligned with standards developed by the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, and the International Technology Education Association. Students will observe teacher demonstration of the following: Tankbot building instructions, Gear demonstration, and ROBOLAB programming demonstration. Students will also build 3-5 robots, program each robot, have races & battles and complete several teacher assigned programming exercises. An open-ended challenge at the end of each activity will reinforce their understanding of motors, timers and programming.

**1. Forces of Nature (Grades K-3)**

Fasten your seatbelts; we're in for some wild weather! This club is all about the amazing and powerful forces of nature, as students explore the when, where, how and why of all kinds of natural phenomenon. There is a lot of geography in this unit -- we'll examine a map of the Pacific "Ring of Fire" where most tsunamis occur, view a diagram of the tectonic plates and learn how their movement creates earthquakes, define the area known as "Tornado Alley" in North America, and find out what hurricanes are called in different parts of the world. These lessons are designed to improve your child's understanding of the forces of nature, while taking care not to alarm. Each model represents the motion of that particular weather or event, with a seat for a mini-figure to take in the action! Kids will love to build moving models of a tornado, a tsunami, an earthquake and a cyclone. Learn how they move, why they happen and what you can do to stay safe!

6. If you are paying by **Cash**, still press **"Check out with PayPal"** this will capture and submit your registration information, then close the payment window. ## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How do I know if my child is enrolled in a Maugham After-School Club?**

**By Thursday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, you will receive an email with the class list of the club. If you do not hear from us by then, please** contact one of the club chairs.

Please note: there are a limited number of children who can be admitted to each club. ONLINE REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE WHEN ENROLLMENT MEETS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER A CLUB CAN HANDLE. THIS YEAR, THERE WILL BE AN OPTION FOR YOU TO ADD YOUR NAME TO A WAITLIST. IF AN ENROLLED STUDENT DROPS BEFORE THE CLUB BEGINS, WE WILL TAKE STUDENTS FROM THE WAITLIST TO FILL THE CLASS. There is a minimum number of children needed to cover the cost of each club. If a club must be cancelled due to low enrollment, we will try to put you in your second choice if one is listed and available. If there is a cost difference, we will contact you about the necessary dollar exchange.

### **What is the Maugham After-School Club Refund Policy?**

**The HSA does not refund club fees.** If your child is absent from a regular or rescheduled club meeting, drops out of the club after the club fee is paid, is removed from a club, or if there is an unscheduled snow-day or emergency closing, no refund will be given. If, in the judgment of the Club Supervisor, a student is not working well in a club, their club membership will be withdrawn. You will **not** receive a refund. In addition, that student will not be allowed to register for the same club in the following session.

**What is the Maugham After-School Club Dismissal Policy?**

Please indicate on the online registration form how you would like your child dismissed from the club: to be met at the door by a parent or guardian or to be released to leave the building alone. **This is very important.** Please pay attention when indicating dismissal instructions.
